

Before the injection:

- 1. Ladies: PLEASE do not wear eye make-up to your appointment.
- 2. Bring a driver.

What to expect after the injection?

- 1. Although during the procedure, your eye is numb with gel, some patients feel the pain a few hours after the injection.
- 2. Your eye will be scratchy and have a red spot on the surface.
- 3. You may see a bubble or a black circle (floater) in the eye. Don't get worried as that is the medicine. You will notice the bubble disappear in a day or two.
- 4. You may be given a prescription ointment to be applied 3 times a day for three days and it will blur your vision for some time.

After the procedure, you are advised to do the following:

- 1. **Do not** rub your eye, get soap in your eye, or get water in your eye for 1 day after the procedure.
- 2. You should take Tylenol to make you feel comfortable.
- 3. No eye make-up for 2 days after you injection.
- 4. If you feel the eyelid swollen, you can do warm compresses.
- 5. If you feel eye soreness, you can apply ointment as prescribed by Dr. Khetpal.
